## HEATHER HAT



### SIZE

To fit an average sized adult woman's head.

Approx circumference 44.5 cm (17½ in)

## **YARN**

Softest Alpaca (50gm)

### **NEEDLES**

1 pair of 5mm (no 6) (US 8) needles (for version worked flat) 1 pair 5.5mm (no 5) (US 9) needles (for version worked flat)

5mm (no 6) (US 8) circular needles meas 40cm (for version worked in the round) 5.5mm (no 5) (US 9) circular needles meas 40cm (for version worked in the round)

Set of 5.5mm (no 5) (US 9) double pointed needles (for version worked in the round)

#### **TENSION**

18 sts and 25 ows / rounds to 10 cm measured over checkerboard patt using  $5.5 \, \mathrm{mm}$  (US 9) needles

#### **EXTRAS**

Stitch marker (for version worked in the round)

#### SIZE

To fit an average sized adult woman's hand.

#### **YARN**

Softest Alpaca (50gm)

## **NEEDLES**

Set of 5mm (no 6) (US 8) double pointed needles Set of 5.5mm (no 5) (US 9) double pointed needles

## **TENSION**

18 sts and 25 rows to 10 cm measured over checkerboard patt using 5.5mm (US 9) needles

## **EXTRAS**

Stitch marker Stitch holder (for thumb)

#### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**M1P** - make 1 stitch left, insert the left needle under the strand that runs between the next stitch from front to back, purl this strand through the back loop.

M1L – make 1 stitch left, insert the left needle under the strand that runs between the next stitch from front to back, knit this strand through the back loop.

M1R – make 1 right, insert the left needle under the strand that runs between the next stitch from back to front, knit this strand.
