both using 7mm (US 10½) needles.

### NEEDLES

1 pair 6mm (no 4) (US 10) needles  
 1 pair 7mm (no 2) (US 10½) needles  
 Cable needle

### TENSION

13½ sts and 20 rows to 10 cm measured over side patt using 7mm (US 10½) needles.  
 Cable panel (52 sts) meas 35 cm.

### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**C3B** = slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work, K1, then K2 from cable needle; **C3F** = slip next st onto cable needle and leave at front of work, K2, then K1 from cable needle.

#### Softest Merino Wool

### NEEDLES

1 pair 6mm (no 4) (US 10) needles  
1 pair 7mm (no 2) (US 10½) needles  
6mm (no 4) (US 10) circular needle, at least 100  
cm long

### TENSION

13½ sts and 19 rows to 10 cm measured over st st,  
13 sts and 22 rows to 10 cm measured over patt,  
both using 7mm (US 10½) needles.

### **YARN**

**Softest Merino Wool**

2 x 100gm  
(photographed in Seal 015)

### **NEEDLES**

7mm (no 2) (US 10½) circular needle, no longer than 70 cm for version that is knitted in rounds, or at least 80 cm long for version that is knitted flat

### **TENSION**

14 sts and 20 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 7mm (US 10½) needles.

### **FINISHED SIZE**

Completed cowl has a circumference of approx 75 cm (29½ in) and is 24 cm (9½ in) deep.

### **YARN**

#### **Softest Merino Wool**

Hat 1 x 100gm

Scarf 3 x 100gm

(photographed in Laurel 012)

### **NEEDLES**

Set of 4 double-pointed 7mm (no 2) (US 10½) needles

1 pair 7mm (no 2) (US 10½) needles

### **TENSION**

13.5 sts and 20 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 7mm (no 2) (US 10½) needles.

### **FINISHED SIZE**

Completed scarf meas 168 cm (66 in) long and 21 cm (8½ in) wide.
