To fit bust

91-97 102-107 112-117 122-127 132-137cm

Actual chest measurement of garment

YARN

Felted Tweed

A Seafarer 170

8 9 10 11 11 x 50gm

B Clay 177

4 4 4 5 5 x 50gm

NEEDLES

1 pair 3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) needles

1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) circular needle no more than 40 cm long

TENSION

25 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 4mm (US 6) needles.

BACK

Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles and yarn A cast on 150 [162: 174: 186: 202] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K2, *P2, K2, rep from * to end.

Row 2: P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to end. These 2 rows form rib.

Cont in rib until work meas 6 cm, inc [inc: inc: inc: dec] 1 st at end of last row and ending with RS facing for next row.

151 [163: 175: 187: 201] sts.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Join in yarn B.

Beg and ending rows as indicated, using the **fairisle** technique as described on the information page and repeating the 16 row patt
