## NEEDLES

1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles 4mm (no 8) (US 6) circular needle at least 100 cm long Cable needle

## **TENSION**

20% sts and 36 rows to 10~cm measured over pattern using 4mm (US 6) needles and yarn DOUBLE.

## FINISHED SIZE

Completed shawl measures 128.5 cm (50% in) along cast-off edge and is approx 35 cm (13% in) measured along centre of each set of 5 diamonds.

**Pattern note:** All slipped sts should be worked purlwise with yarn held at front (WS) of work (so strand of yarn "sits" across WS of work).

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

C2B = slip next st onto cable needle and leave at back of work, K1, then K1 from cable needle; C2F = slip next st onto cable needle and leave at front of work, K1, then K1 from cable needle; M1L = insert left needle from front to back into the horizontal strand between last st worked and next st on left needle, then knit this strand through the back of the loop; M1R = insert left needle from back to front into the horizontal strand between last st worked and next st on left needle, then knit this strand through the front of the loop; sl 2 = keeping yarn at front (WS) of work, slip next 2 sts purlwise one at a time.
