



Completed hat is 54.5~cm ($21\frac{1}{2}~\text{in}$) in circumference and 20.5~cm (8~in) deep with rib brim folded over.

knitting into back of this loop; M1LP = make a stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch with left needle inserting point of needle from front to back of this loop, then purling into back of this loop; M1R = make a stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch with left needle inserting point of needle from back to front of this loop, then knitting into front of this loop; M1RP = make a stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch with left needle inserting point of needle from back to front of this loop, then purling into front of this loop.
